forest risks









PLURIFOR gathers scientific experts to design or improve management plans and tools tackling 8 forest risks.

Forests cover more than 30% of France, Spain and Portugal together, hosting biodiversity, providing environmental services and generating economic activities.

This is all threatened by biotic and abiotic hazards that do not stop at administrative borders.

In order to mitigate the consequences of these risks in south-western European forests, transboundary collaboration is a vital component of PLURIFOR.
